# The Education Abroad Program



EAP is part of the UCLA International Education Office (IEO). The IEO serves as the campuswide gateway to international education by developing, publicizing, and administering study abroad and student exchange programs. IEO programs include EAP, Travel Study, Quarter Abroad, non-UC programs, and various student exchange agreements. The IEO encourages all students to explore the many opportunities available. Last year, over 2,300 UCLA students chose to study and learn abroad. You'll broaden your perspective and open the door to a whole world of possibilities.

EAP offers different types of programs of varying lengths. Before you choose which program you'd like to apply for, it might be helpful to think about whether you're interested in:

### LANGUAGE AND CULTURE PROGRAMS:

You'll receive a solid introduction to the country where you are studying by taking language and civilization courses.

### IMMERSION PROGRAMS:

You'll be a regular student at the local university and take classes with host university students.

### SPECIAL FOCUS PROGRAMS:

You can concentrate on a specific field of study at a foreign institution. There are programs specially designed for economics, science, psychology, engineering, global studies, and many other majors.

You might also consider how long you'd like to be abroad:

**Short-term programs** (summer-, quarter-, or semester-long programs) may help you fit study abroad into your family life or educational goals.

**Long-term programs** are ideal if you want to learn as much as you possibly can about a language or culture.

And, of course, you'll need to decide which country to choose.



Whatever program you choose, applying is easy. Remember to get started early, as much as a year before you plan to leave. Admission happens on a first-come, first-served basis and many programs fill up quickly. Go to [www.ieo.ucla.edu/eap](http://www.ieo.ucla.edu/eap), click on apply, fill out an online application, and indicate the program you're interested in. Be sure to read the application instructions for any supplemental documentation needed for your application. The GPA requirement varies by program.

**Transfer students** are encouraged to consider EAP. You are welcome to start the process by looking into the programs even when you've only just applied to UCLA. If you didn't think of it before you were admitted to UCLA, there are several short-term programs that may work for you. You can also consider spending part of your fourth year abroad.

**Financial aid** is available to qualified applicants and there are many scholarships. For more information visit [www.ieo.ucla.edu/EAP/financialaid.htm](http://www.ieo.ucla.edu/EAP/financialaid.htm). Don't let financial worries stand in the way of study abroad.

**Academic integration** is planned into the EAP experience. Units and grades transfer back to UCLA automatically. And with some planning before you go, it's easy to select courses that will count toward major or GE requirements.
